F.A.S.T. Is an easy way for everyone to recognise the signs of stroke, ***F.A.S.T.?*** Stands for **Facial weakness Arm weakness, Speech difficulty and Time to act: - *F.A.S.T.*...**

Using the FAST test involves asking three simple questions. Can the person smile? - Has their mouth or eyes dropped? Can the person raise both arms? Can the person speak clearly and understand what you say?
