Wednesday, 28 May 2014:-

CAO drove to the Allamanda Private Hospital Rehabilitation Unit where 100 copies of the Notices of Meetings to be held on 4 June 2014 and 2 July 2014 were photocopied by xx xx and later on to be put into the envelopes for posting.

A notice for 1/Dave & Ruth Gallop was handed to Ruth Gallop in the Rehabilitation Unit.

CAO then drove to Margaret Hamilton's home where she and CAO put the labels on to the envelopes. They then put the notices into the envelopes for posting.
